NEW HANDICAPS

A WHS Handicap Index will be granted to a member when he / she has submitted the required number of 9 hole and/or 18 hole properly completed scorecards (*) covering a total minimum of 54 holes over the Measured Course when the condition of the course is suitable for handicap qualifying rounds of golf to be played; check with the shop before you play. Scorecards must be signed by the member him/herself and annotated with the name of the QUALIFIED MARKER he / she played with. These scorecards MUST BE from Pryors Hayes; scorecards from other clubs or societies are not acceptable for this purpose.

(*) Strokes entered per hole; player's name; date played; player's signature.

QUALIFIED MARKER -

- A member of an affiliated golf club who has a WHS Handicap Index.
- The name of the marker (and their Golf Club if the marker is not a member at PHGC) must be clearly PRINTED on each scorecard. No signature is required!!

 If the marker information is omitted or illegible the scorecard will not be accepted.

All scorecards should be clearly marked at the top - 'FOR HANDICAP PURPOSES ONLY'.

Please clearly identify on each scorecard, which tee box you have played your round from i.e. White, Yellow or Red tees (circle as appropriate at the top right of the scorecard).

When <u>ALL</u> the 54 holes have been played, the completed scorecards should be scanned or photographed and sent electronically by email into the golf club at <u>info@pryorshayes.co.uk</u>

The newly awarded / issued *WHS Handicap Index* will be advised to the player by email.
