World Handicap System (change effective 1st April 2024)

The Course Handicap calculation is changing so that it is: "relative to par, making a golfer's target score to 'play to handicap' more intuitive"

The New Course Handicap calculation will be adjusted by: 'COURSE RATING (CR) minus PAR'

Club Competitions:

Course Handicaps will be adjusted thus:

White Tees (CR 70.2 minus PAR 70) = adjustment 0.2 added Yellow Tees (CR 67.9 minus PAR 70) = adjustment 2.1 deducted Red Tees (CR 71.0 minus PAR 70) = adjustment 1.0 added

Playing Handicaps will continue to be calculated in ClubV1 / HowDidiDo however the adjusted Course Handicap will be calculated to one decimal place and the appropriate competition handicap allowance will then be applied to give a more accurate rounded Playing Handicap i.e. the Course Handicap will not be rounded before the Playing Handicap is calculated.

General Play / Casual Rounds:

The adjusted Course Handicap will be automatically calculated for a player by ClubV1 / HowDidiDo / MyEG when the player signs in. (No Playing Handicap Allowances are applied for these rounds!)

New updated Course Handicap tables will be displayed at the entrance to the clubhouse.
